Explanation: Funds are required to address a growing and pressing need to refocus a portion of current cleanup funding from Army active sites to Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS) to respond to both a significant increase in environmental and explosive safety hazards posed by Munitions of Concern (MEC) and Munitions Constituents (MC) identified in the Department's Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) at FUDS sites, and growing number of high risk FUDS sites ready for remedial action implementation in the conventional Installation Restoration program (IRP). Transferring these funds will better enable the FUDS program to achieve the greatest possible degree of risk reduction, while maintaining a funding balance between the MMRP and IRP.
