This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because these actions exceed established reprogramming thresholds and affect congressional special interest items. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

PART I of this reprogramming action realigns \$1.6 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Army, 10/12, appropriation and \$76.306 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 10/11, appropriation.

PART II of this reprogramming action realigns \$2.325 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Army, 09/11, appropriation.
