This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because these actions use general and special transfer authority, exceeds established reprogramming thresholds, affects a congressional special interest item, and initiates a <u>new start</u>. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress. Some adjustments in this reprogramming impact the Military Intelligence Program (MIP) and are initiatives supported by the Secretary of Defense's Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR) Task Force (TF).

<u>PART I</u> of this reprogramming action transfers \$86.3 million among Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$62.491 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of P.L. 111-118, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2010; and section 1001 of Public Law 111-84, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010.

PART II of this reprogramming action transfers \$38.5 million between Air Force appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$38.5 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 9002 of Public Law 111-118, the DoD Appropriation Act, 2010.
