This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. Specifically, this reprogramming action transfers \$0.2 million between Defense appropriations for support and services for eligible organizations and activities outside the Department of Defense pursuant to section 2012 of title 10, United States Code. These funds are transferred pursuant to section 8051 of Division A of Public Law 112-74, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2012 and section 1001 of Public Law 112-81, the National Defense Authorization Act, 2012. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
