This reprogramming action transfers \$16.5 million from the Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) Vehicle Fund, 12/13, appropriation to the Other Procurement, Air Force, 13/15, appropriation for execution in Fiscal Year (FY) 2013. This is pursuant to the authority provided in Title IX Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) of Division A of Public Law 112-74, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2012. The Mine Resistant Ambush Protected (MRAP) vehicle program is a critical priority joint-Service program, which supports urgent warfighter needs for the protection of operating forces in Afghanistan.
