This reprogramming action is in two parts.

Part II transfers \$15.6 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 12/13, appropriation to various Components' appropriations consistent with the provisions in Title IX OCO of Division A of Public Law 112-74, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2012.

Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense, Counternarcotics and Global Threats. This reprogramming impacts the **Military Intelligence Program (MIP)**.
