This reprogramming action is in three parts.

<u>Part I</u> transfers \$3.188 million of previously transferred funds from the various Components' appropriation back into the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 13/13, appropriation, consistent with the provisions of Division C of Public Law 113-6, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2013.

<u>Part II</u> transfers \$461.536 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 13/13, appropriation to various Components' appropriations for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities, consistent with the provisions of Division C of Public Law 113-6, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2013.

<u>Part III</u> transfers \$61.404 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 13/14, appropriation to various Components' appropriations for Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) related drug interdiction and counter-drug activities, consistent with the provisions in Title IX OCO of Division C of Public Law 113-6, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2013.

Realignment of funds between counter-drug projects may be accomplished only with prior approval of the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense, Counternarcotics and Global Threats. Realignment of funds to and from the Drug Demand Reduction Program may only be accomplished with the prior approval of the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense, Personnel and Readiness. This reprogramming impacts the **Military Intelligence Program (MIP)**.
