This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval in accordance with established procedures for reprogramming under section 1001 of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 (Public Law 112-239). This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$11.911 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 13/13, appropriation to the Global Security Contingency Fund, 12/15, appropriation. This reprogramming uses \$11.911 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 8068 of division C of Public Law 113-6, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2013 and is in accordance with section 1207 of Public Law 112-81, the NDAA for FY 2012.

Explanation: Funds are required to build the Government of Libya's cross-ministerial capacity to secure Libya's borders and reduce the threats of terrorism, weapons proliferation, and illicit trafficking.

Explanation: Funds are available from those authorized under the Global Train and Equip program (section 1206 of Public Law 109-163, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2006, as amended), due to a higher priority requirement. The Global Security Contingency Fund (GSCF) Libya Border Security program is consistent with the intent and purpose of section 1206 as a counterterrorism capacity-building authority. This GSCF program is designed to build the capacity of both Ministry of Interior forces, excluded from section 1206 authority, and Ministry of Defense forces for border security operations, which includes interdiction operations to respond to terrorist threats.
