This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval in accordance with established procedures for reprogramming under section 1001 of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 (Public Law 112-239). This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$24.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 13/13, appropriation to the Global Security Contingency Fund, 12/15, appropriation. This reprogramming uses \$24.0 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 8068 of Division C of Public Law 113-6, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2013 and is in accordance with section 1207 of Public Law 112-81, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2012.

**FY 2013 REPROGRAMMING INCREASE:** **+24,000**

Explanation: Funds are required to support the Philippine government’s efforts to accelerate transition of internal defense and counter terrorism responsibilities to civilian law enforcement and ensure the Philippine military can provide a credible defense posture in response to rising geostrategic pressures, particularly in the South China Sea.
