This reprogramming action transfers \$39.895 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 14/14, appropriation to the Services' Operation and Maintenance, 14/14, appropriations for proper execution of the Transition Assistance Program across the Department. This reprogramming action uses \$39.895 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Division C of Public Law 113 76, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2014, and section 1001 of Public Law 113-66, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2014. Reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. This action does not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
