These reprogramming actions transfer funds between appropriations for proper execution. Reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$25.336 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 14/14, appropriation to various Components' appropriations to support Sexual Assault Prevention Special Victims' Programs across the Department pursuant to section 8124 of Division C of Public Law 113-76, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2014.

In addition, this reprogramming action uses \$0.336 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Division C of Public Law 113 76, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2014; and section 1001 of Public Law 113-66, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2014, because it exceeds the limitation set in section 8124 of Division C of Public Law 113-76, DoD Appropriations Act, 2014.
