This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$2.035 million between Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 Navy appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$2.035 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Division C of Public 113-76, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2014, and section 1001 of Public Law 113-66, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2014.

Explanation: Funds are transferred from the Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 14/14, appropriation to the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Navy, 14/15, appropriation for proper execution for the following:

- \$+0.675 million to complete a marine resource survey to provide quantitative data and information on the seasonal occurrence, distribution, and density of marine mammals in the Atlantic Test Range area. This is a congressional special interest item. This is a base budget requirement.
- \$+ 1.111 million to conduct field surveys to identify and evaluate historic sites to minimize impact of operational activities related to research, development, test and evaluation at Navy test ranges. This is a congressional special interest item. This is a base budget requirement.
- \$+0.249 million to monitor marine mammals (M3R) on Navy ranges. The ranges are being leveraged for a multidisciplinary study that combines M3R passive acoustics, expert on-water visual observers, and the placement of satellite tags. This is a congressional special interest item. This is a base budget requirement.
