This reprogramming action is being submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority and exceeds established reprogramming thresholds. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$39.0 million among Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 Navy appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$21.855 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Division C of Public Law 113-6, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2013 and section 1001 of Public Law 112-239, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2013.
