This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions exceed established reprogramming thresholds, and affect a congressional special interest item. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action realigns \$130.0 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 12/14, appropriation.

Explanation: Funds are required to procure spares for the C-5 Galaxy Reliability Enhancement and Re-engineering Program (RERP). This is the first step in the Department's funding plan to comply with section 1098 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2014 (Public Law 113-66). In section 1098, the Congress requires the Department of the Air Force to modify seven HC-130H aircraft, which were transferred from the Department of Homeland Security (U.S. Coast Guard), for fire suppression purposes and subsequent transfer to the Department of Agriculture (U.S. Forest Service). Upon submission of the baseline for application of reprogramming report for Fiscal Year 2014 required by section 8007 of the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2014 (Division C of Public Law 113-76), the Department will submit a future reprogramming action to realign \$130.0 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 14/16, appropriation, from the spares program for the C-5 RERP to the C-130 modification program to modify the transferred HC-130H aircraft before they are transferred to the U.S. Forest Services. This 2-step funding plan is consistent with the joint Office of Management and Budget and Department of Defense certification letter sent to the Congress on February 7, 2014. This is a base budget requirement.
