This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use general transfer authority, exceed established reprogramming thresholds, and initiate new starts. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

<u>Part I</u> of this reprogramming action transfers or realigns \$113.035 million between Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 Air Force appropriations. This reprogramming uses \$83.852 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 division C of Public Law 113-235, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2015; and section 1001 of Public Law 113-291, the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2015.

<u>Part II</u> of this reprogramming action realigns \$4.6 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 15/17, appropriation.

Funds are required to meet an urgent need, which cannot otherwise be met due to the production leadtime of greater than 18 months for the AESA radar. A follow on Phase II of this JUON may be initiated at the conclusion of several Joint Staff Homeland Defense studies, estimated for completion in December 2015. This is a new start.
