This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because this action exceeds established reprogramming thresholds and affects a congressional special interest item. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action realigns \$50.0 million within the Procurement of Weapons and Tracked Combat Vehicles, Army, 15/17, appropriation.

Explanation: Funds are required to procure Stryker Double-V Hull (DVH) vehicles for the third Stryker DVH brigade prior to the expiration of a negotiated contract option at the end of June 2015. This funding, in addition to requested Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 funding, supports the Army's strategy for Stryker DVH procurement and enables completion of the third DVH brigade set. This is a base budget requirement.

Explanation: Funds provided by a congressional add specified for the fourth Stryker Double-V Hull (DVH) brigade set are ahead of need because the planned production start for this brigade will not occur before the third quarter of FY 2016. This schedule is based on the Stryker Engineering Change Proposal 1 (ECP1), which will not be ready for production until then. The ECP1 effort includes increases in engine horsepower and alternator output to accept the modernized in-vehicle network, and delivers a more ruggedized suspension. The fourth Stryker DVH brigade will achieve savings of approximately \$195 thousand per vehicle by executing ECP1 simultaneously with the DVH modification. The proposed funding realignment will not delay production of the fourth Stryker DVH brigade. This is base budget funding.
