This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers or realigns \$31,011 million among Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$3.7 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public 114-113, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2016, and section 1001 of Public Law 114-92, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2016.
