This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because this action uses general transfer authority and exceeds established reprogramming thresholds. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$17.1 million between Fiscal Year (FY) 2015 Army appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$17.1 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public Law 113-235, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2015; and section 1001 of Public Law 113-291, the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2015.

Explanation: Funds are required to support critical technology development activities required to develop and test Pseudolites. This effort is part of a multipronged approach to provide Army forces with unhindered access to trusted Positioning, Navigation, and Timing information during outages. Lack of funding will delay Pseudolite Milestone B and Initial Operational Capability by 12 months, impacting Army's ability to conduct unfettered operations. This is a base budget requirement.
