This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted because it exceeds established reprogramming thresholds and affects congressional special interest items. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which funds were originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been denied previously by the Congress.

This reprogramming action realigns \$30.955 million within the National Guard and Reserve Equipment, Defense-Wide, 14/16, appropriation.

This reprogramming action is associated with letters sent to the congressional defense committees by the Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Manpower and Reserve Affairs), dated September 3, 2015, stating the Department’s intent to repurpose the Marine Corps Reserve funding.

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Explanation: Funds are required to support the following requirements previously submitted on the original Army Reserve Acquisition Plan approved by the congressional defense committees on July 11, 2014. Both of these requirements were identified as Army Reserve equipment shortfalls in the DoD National Guard and Reserve Equipment Report for Fiscal Year (FY) 2016:

- \$+3.4 million for the procurement of 10 additional High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle Ambulances. The original Acquisition Plan included funding for 60 ambulances, which was subsequently reduced to 35 due to reprioritization resulting from the Army baseline budget changes. This is an OCO budget requirement.
- \$+3.2 million for the procurement of eight additional Heavy Expanded Mobility Tactical Truck (HEMTT) Cargo Trucks. The original Acquisition Plan included funding for 65 trucks, which was subsequently reduced to 40 due to unit price increase. This is an OCO budget requirement.
