This reprogramming action transfers \$26.351 million from the Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund (CTPF), 15/16, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 16/16, appropriation (\$3.510 million) and Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 16/16, appropriation (\$23.0 million) for proper execution. This transfer is pursuant to the authority provided in Title IX Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) under the heading "Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund" of division C of Public Law 113-235, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2015 and section 1534 of Public Law 113-291, the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have been previously denied by the Congress. This reprogramming impacts the **Military Intelligence Program (MIP)**.

**FY 2016 REPROGRAMMING INCREASES:** **+26,510**

**Operation and Maintenance, Air Force, 16/16** **+3,510**  
Budget Activity 01: Operating Forces **+3,510**

Explanation: Funds are required for acquisition of additional United States Battlefield Information Collection and Exploitation System – Extended (U.S. BICES-X) capabilities, to include hardware, software, peripherals, and bandwidth expansion in support of the USAFRICOM AOR. Additional U.S. BICES-X capabilities enhance the sharing of near real-time information and intelligence between the United States and Coalition and Foreign Partner Nations in support of Counterterrorism (CT) operations. This is a **MIP** project. This is an OCO budget requirement.

**Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 16/16** **+23,000**  
Classified Programs **+23,000**

Explanation: Funds are required to provide 12 months of contract Airborne Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance services supporting U.S. Africa Command (USAFRICOM) Area of Responsibility (AOR). This is a **MIP** project. This is an OCO budget requirement.

**FY 2016 REPROGRAMMING DECREASE:** **-26,510**

**Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund, 15/16** **-26,510**  
Public Law 114-113 1,300,000 62,561 **-26,510** 36,051

Explanation: Funds are available from the CTPF to improve the capacity of the United States Armed Forces to provide enabling support to foreign security forces or other groups or individuals to conduct, facilitate, or support counterterrorism and crisis response activities. This is Title IX OCO budget funding.
