This reprogramming action transfers \$600.0 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 14/14, appropriation to the Defense Acquisition Workforce Development Fund (DAWDF), 17/19, (\$500.0 million) and the DAWDF, 16/18, (\$100.0 million) appropriations pursuant to the authority provided in title 10, United States Code, section 1705, and section 8094, division C of Public Law 113-76, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2014. This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations to satisfy the mandatory credit amount required to be credited to the DAWDF for FY 2016 and FY 2017. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.
