

This reprogramming action transfers \$168.3 million from the Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund (CTEF), 17/18, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army 17/17, appropriation and Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 17/17, appropriation for proper execution. This reprogramming action uses \$168.3 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 9002 of Title IX Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) of the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2017 (division C of Public Law 115-31). This reclassification action restores \$168.3 million to said accounts to cover obligations incurred after transfers in December 2016 from the Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund (CTPF) made available under the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2017 (division C of Public Law 114-223), under prior approval reprogramming action FY17-05 PA. Because the subsequently-enacted DoD Appropriations Act, 2017, did not appropriate a CTPF appropriation, the FY17-05 PA reprogramming has been rescinded. This reclassification action is pursuant to section 107 of the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2017, which authorizes expenditures made pursuant to that Act to be charged to the applicable appropriation or fund upon enactment into law of a bill containing such appropriation. This reclassification is consistent with congressional intent in both its approval of FY17-05 PA and in appropriations made in titles IX and X of the DoD Appropriations Act, 2017 (division C of Public Law 115-31), under the heading "Counter-ISIL Train and Equip Fund".
