This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because this action uses general transfer authority and exceeds established reprogramming thresholds. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.


This reprogramming action transfers \$6.3 million between Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 Army appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$6.3 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public Law 114-113, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2016; and section 1001 of Public Law 114-92, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2016.

Explanation: Funds are required to resume development and testing of the Stinger proximity fuse to address an emerging counter-Unmanned Aircraft System (CUAS) Short Range Air Defense (SHORAD) capability gap. Funding will provide for the engineering analysis, building of test hardware, component and system level testing, and flight testing. This is a base budget requirement.
