This reprogramming action transfers \$4.766 million from the Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund (CTPF), 16/17, appropriation to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 17/17, appropriation for proper execution. This transfer is pursuant to the authority provided in Title IX, Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO), under the heading "Counterterrorism Partnerships Fund," of division C of Public Law 114-113, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2016, and section 1534(e)(2) of Public Law 113-291, the Carl Levin and Howard P. "Buck" McKeon National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015, as amended. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have been previously denied by the Congress.

FY 2017 REPROGRAMMING INCREASE: **+4,766**

Budget Activity 01: Operating Forces **+4,766**

Explanation: Funds are required to improve the capacity of U.S. Armed Forces to provide enabling support to counterterrorism and crisis response activities undertaken by partner nation security forces, and support partner nation interoperability with U.S. forces. Under the authority of the Secretary of Defense to authorize training with friendly foreign countries (10 U.S.C. 321), the U.S. provides support to multinational exercises with African partners, which improve the ability of U.S forces to work with partner nations to contain regional instability, counter violent extremist organizations, maintain border security, and conduct crisis response operations. This is an OCO budget requirement.

FY 2017 REPROGRAMMING DECREASE: **-4,766**
