This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because these actions use general transfer authority and exceed established reprogramming thresholds. These actions reprogram funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements and none of these items have been denied previously by the Congress. Some adjustments in this reprogramming impact the Military Intelligence Program (MIP).

<u>Part I</u> of this reprogramming action transfers or realigns \$10.826 million among Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$4.256 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public Law 115-31, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2017; and section 1001 of Public Law 114-328, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2017.

<u>Part II</u> of this reprogramming action transfers or realigns \$61.7 million among FY 2017 Title IX Overseas Contingency Operations (OCO) Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$57.7 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 9002 of Title IX OCO of division C of Public Law 115-31, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2017.
