This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because this action uses general transfer authority, exceeds established reprogramming thresholds, affects congressional special interest item, and initiates a new start. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$36.1 million among Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 Air Force appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$36.1 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public Law 114-113, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2016; and section 1001 of Public Law 114-92, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2016.



Explanation: Funds are required to demonstrate a new agile software approach to field critically needed capability. This initial effort will pilot dynamic targeting mission upgrades to the Air and Space Operations Center Weapon System for the Air Force Central Command. This pathfinder effort will also establish processes, procedures, and tools to enable an Agile DevOps software pipeline for rapid deployment of future capability upgrades. This is a **new start**. The total cost of this one-time new start is \$36.1 million. This is a base budget requirement.
