This reprogramming action is submitted for prior approval because it uses general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division C of Public Law 115-141, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2018, and section 1001 of Public Law 115-91, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018. This action transfers \$86.131 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 18/18, appropriation to various Components' appropriations for counter-drug related security cooperation training and equipping activates under newly created sections 321, 322, and 333 of Chapter 16, Title 10, United States Code, which were enacted by the National Defense Authorization Act of FY 2017.

This action reprograms funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements than those for which originally appropriated; and is determined to be necessary in the national interest. It meets all administrative and legal requirements and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress. **This action replaces reprogramming action FY 18-19 PA, dated July 10, 2018.**
