This reprogramming action transfers \$64.4 million from various Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 and 2018 Defense appropriations to the Rapid Prototyping Fund, Defense Wide. This action transfers a portion of the penalty for FY 2018 cost overruns on covered major defense acquisition programs of the military departments. This transfer action is made using special transfer authority provided by section 828 of Public Law 114-92, the National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2016, as amended (10 U.S.C. 2430 note). The amounts transferred were proportionally allocated against programs, projects and activities for Procurement and Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation accounts, as required by section 8110 of division C of Public Law 115-141, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2018.
