This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

Part I of this reprogramming action transfers \$3.396 million between Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Army appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$3.396 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division A of Public Law 115-245, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2019; and section 1001 of Public Law 115-232, the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2019.

Part II of this reprogramming action transfers \$0.100 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 19/19, appropriation to the Reserve Personnel, Air Force, 19/19, appropriation for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Programs. These funds are transferred pursuant to section 8052 of division A of Public Law 115-245, the DoD Appropriations Act, 2019.

Explanation: Funds are required to support interim action at Camp Grayling, Michigan to supply drinking water to residents affected by Perfluorooctane Sulfonic Acid and Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOS/PFOA) releases at Grayling Army Airfield. Funding is being transferred from Operation and Maintenance, Army (OMA) to Operation and Maintenance, Army National Guard (OMNG) for the same purpose for proper execution by the Army National Guard. This is a base budget requirement.

Funding is being transferred from OMA to OMNG for the same purpose for proper execution by the Army National Guard. This is a congressional special interest item. This is base budget funding.
