This reprogramming action realigns funds appropriated in Title III of division B of Public Law 116-136, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). The reprogramming provides funding for expenses to prevent, prepare for, or respond to the coronavirus. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have been previously denied by the Congress

This reprogramming action realigns \$4.5 million within Operation and Maintenance, Navy, 20/20, appropriation and \$2.018 million within Operation and Maintenance, Navy Reserve, 20/20, appropriation.
