This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because this action exceeds established reprogramming threshold, and affects a congressional special interest item. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action realigns \$25.0 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Army, 19/20, appropriation.

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Explanation: Funds are required to purchase and integrate hardware for a collaborative interagency project enabling a FY 2021 demonstration of theater tasking and data delivery to Army tactical formations. Additionally, this funding supports terrestrial infrastructure risk reduction activities to enable concept of operations and tactics, techniques, and procedures development through FY 2020. Additional classified details will be provided under separate cover. This **new start** requirement was notified to the committees on the FY 19-13 PA September 2019 Request, without objection, however the committees expressed disagreement with the proposed sources to finance the requirement. This is a base budget requirement.
