This reprogramming action transfers funds between and within appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

**Part I** of this reprogramming action realigns \$5.0 million within the Research, Development, Test, and Evaluation, Defense-Wide, 21/22, appropriation.

**Part II** of this reprogramming realigns \$12.250 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 21/23, appropriation.

**Part III** of this reprogramming action transfers \$1.096 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 21/21, appropriation to the Services' Military Personnel, 21/21, appropriations for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Programs. These funds are transferred pursuant to section 8054 of division C of Public Law 116-260, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2021.
