This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$3.320 million from the Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 22/22, appropriation to the Services' Military Personnel, 22/22, appropriations for the Department's Innovative Readiness Training (IRT) Civil Military Programs. These funds are transferred pursuant to the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2022, division A of Public Law 117-70, and section 8054 of division C of Public Law 116-260, the Department of Defense (DoD) Appropriations Act, 2021.
