This reprogramming action transfers the \$496.324 million of the \$500.000 million appropriated in section 201 of Title II of Public Law 117-128, Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022, to various Defense procurement appropriations for execution. This reprogramming action provides funding for the procurement of critical munitions to increase stocks of the Department of Defense. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have been previously denied by the Congress.

The transfer authority provided by section 201 is in addition to any other transfer authority available to the Department of Defense.
