This reprogramming action transfers \$180.803 million from the funding appropriated in section 2301 of title III of division N of Public Law 117-103, the Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022, to Operation and Maintenance, Air Force for execution. This reprogramming action provides funding for the replacement of defense articles from the stocks of the Department of Defense, and for reimbursement for defense services of the Department of Defense and military education and training provided to the Government of Ukraine. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have been previously denied by the Congress.

The transfer authority provided in Section 2301 is in addition to any other transfer authority available to the Department of Defense.
