This reprogramming action realigns funds between appropriations for proper execution to respond to the situation in Ukraine. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. These actions do not use general transfer authority. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

**PART I** of this reprogramming action realigns \$0.600 million within the Other Procurement, Army, 22/24, appropriation previously transferred to that account pursuant to Ukraine Replacement Transfer Fund Tranche #8 (FY 22-43 IR) from the funding appropriated for Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 22/23, in title II of the Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022 (Public Law 117-128).

**PART II** of this reprogramming action realigns \$149.842 million within the Procurement of Ammunition, Army, 23/25, appropriation previously transferred to that account pursuant to Ukraine Replacement Transfer Fund Tranche #9 (FY 23-07 IR) from the funding appropriated for Operation and Maintenance, Defense-Wide, 22/23, in title II of the Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022 (Public Law 117-128).

**PART III** of this reprogramming action realigns \$0.102 million within the Procurement of Weapons and Tracked Combat Vehicles, Army, 22/24, appropriation received in title II of the Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022 (Public Law 117-128).
