This reprogramming action transfers \$285.929 million from the funding appropriated in section 2301 of title II of division N of Public Law 117-103, the Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022, to the Operation and Maintenance, Army, 23/23, appropriation and the Procurement of Weapons and Tracked Combat Vehicles, Army, 23/25, appropriation for execution. The reprogramming action provides funding for the replacement of defense articles from the stocks of the Department of Defense, and for reimbursement for defense services of the Department of Defense and military education and training provided to the Government of Ukraine. This action is determined to be necessary in the national interest. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have been previously denied by the Congress.

The transfer authority provided by Section 2301 is in addition to any other transfer authority available to the Department of Defense.
