This reprogramming action realigns funds within the Operation and Maintenance appropriation for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action realigns \$198.66 million within the Operation and Maintenance, Navy 23/23, appropriation provided in in division M of Public Law 117-328, the Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2023.

The evolving nature of Ukraine support requirements resulted in adjustments to mission tasking impacting the Navy’s requirements for ship operations and additional costs for port visits and repair parts by the USS Gerald R. Ford Carrier Strike Group while operating in the U.S. European Command (EUCOM) Area of Responsibility. Also required are costs to support maintenance of USS Kearsarge returning from U.S. European Command (EUCOM) Area of Responsibility supporting NATO. This is a congressional special interest item.
