SUBJECT: Department of Defense Transfer to Department of State (FY 23-13 LTR)

This memorandum implements the transfer of \$1,329.8 million from the Overseas Humanitarian, Disaster, and Civic Aid (OHDACA), Defense-Wide, 22/23, appropriation to the Department of State (DoS) pursuant to section 122(a) of the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2023 (division A of Public Law (P.L.) 117-180) (**TAB A**).

During FY 2023, the Department of Defense will continue transitioning operations and responsibilities under Operation Allies Welcome (OAW) to the Department of State. OHDACA transfers from the Department of Defense, as authorized by section 122(a) of the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2023 (division A of P.L. 117-180), is vital to efforts to transition operations and activities previously supported by the Department of Defense to the Department of State, thereby supporting OAW or any successor operation and reaffirming the U.S. government's long-term commitment to supporting our Afghan allies and partners. The following planned uses of funds are based on current planning assumptions. Funds will be used only in accordance with applicable legal authorities.

The attached congressional notifications, CN 23-250 (**TAB B**) and CN 23-251 (**TAB C**), provide the details for this transfer.

The reprogramming action may be transferred pending OMB's approval of the letter apportionments.
