This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use general or special transfer authority, exceeds established reprogramming thresholds, affects special interest items, or initiate a new start. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

**Part I** of this reprogramming action realigns \$15.50 million within the Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 22/24, appropriation.

**Part II** of this reprogramming action transfers \$61.15 million between Fiscal Year 2022 Army appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$31.50 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2022 (division C of Public Law 117-103), and section 1001 of Public Law 117-81, the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for FY 2022.

Explanation: Funds are available due to the initial B-Kit procurement for APR-39E(V)2 countermeasure equipment originally scheduled for FY 2022 that moved to FY 2023. The production decision has been delayed until system qualification and performance testing can be completed to show stability in design.
