This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use general or special transfer authority, exceed established reprogramming thresholds, affect special interest items, or initiate a new start. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and, are determined to be in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$28.0 million from the Drug Interdiction and Counter-Drug Activities, Defense, 23/23, appropriation to Aircraft Procurement, Air Force, 23/25 appropriation, for drug interdiction and counter-drug activities. This reprogramming action uses \$28.0 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of Division C of Public Law 117-328, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2023, and section 1001 of Public Law 117-263, the National Defense Authorization Act, 2023.

Explanation: Funds are required to purchase, configure, and deploy maritime patrol surveillance aircraft to support continued counternarcotics and detection monitoring activities pursuant to Title 10, U.S.C. Section 174, in the U.S. Southern Command area of responsibility. The Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2023, provided funds for one maritime patrol surveillance aircraft. This reprogramming will allow for the purchase of a second aircraft. This is a congressional special interest item.
