This reprogramming action transfers funds between appropriations for proper execution. The reclassification is required to execute funds properly in accordance with congressional intent. These actions are determined to be necessary in the national interest. These actions do not change the purpose for which the funds were originally appropriated. This reprogramming action meets all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items has been previously denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$785.104 million between Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$643.342 million of special transfer authority pursuant to section 101 in division B of Public Law 118-50, the Ukraine Security Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2024.

The transfer authority provided in Public Law 118-50 is in addition to any other transfer authority available to the Department of Defense.
