This prior approval reprogramming action is submitted for approval because these actions use general or special transfer authority, exceed established reprogramming thresholds, affect special interest items, or indicate a new start. This reprogramming action provides funding in support of higher priority items, based on unforeseen military requirements, than those for which originally appropriated; and are determined to be necessary in the national interest. They meet all administrative and legal requirements, and none of the items have previously been denied by the Congress.

This reprogramming action transfers \$540.00 million between Defense appropriations. This reprogramming action uses \$540.00 million of general transfer authority pursuant to section 8005 of division A of Public Law 118-47, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2024, and section 1001 of P.L. 118-31, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024.

Although this action seeks to re-classify funding for proper execution, as detailed below, and pertains to funding provided in the Ukraine Security Supplemental Appropriations Act (Division B of P.L. 118-50) and therefore does not technically apply to a congressional special interest item as that term is defined in recurring explanatory statements, the Department submits this action for prior approval based on the nature and amount of the funds involved.

Explanation: Funds are required to continue the provision of specific sustainment and maintenance for the Ukrainian Armed Forces, which the Department has historically resourced with funds for the Ukraine Security Assistance Initiative (USAI). Maintenance and sustainment support, such as spare parts and repair services for previously provided systems, technical data packages, maintenance innovation, and other capabilities, remain urgently needed in Ukraine. Much of this equipment can only be procured from industry and cannot be provided from DoD stocks or via security cooperation authorities such as Title 10, Section 331, necessitating the transfer of funding into USAI. This is a congressional special interest item. This is an emergency budget requirement.
