<u>Project Description</u>: Construct group and squadron operations facilities with concrete foundation and floor slab, steel frame, masonry walls and sloped metal roof. Functional areas include areas such as staff and administration, planning and briefing areas, secure open storage and planning vault, mobility storage, life support/aircrew flight equipment storage and maintenance. Construct aircraft parts and Mobility Readiness Spare Packages warehouse with associated external covered and uncovered storage elements.

<u>Justification</u>: Additional funding is required to award the secured storage area and provide a complete and usable facility that meets mission requirements. The cost increase results primarily from delays caused by a redesign to comply with Sensitive Compartmented Information Facility (SCIF) construction requirements and limited contractor availability to support SCIF construction. Concurrently, ongoing supply chain impacts resulting from the Covid-19 pandemic, global chip shortage, and the beginning of the Russia-Ukraine war in Feb 2022 (following completion of design but pre contract award) also contributed to material price increases which consumed all available contingency funding.

A 10 U.S.C. §2853 cost variation notification is not required for this request.
