\* On January 1, 1999, the euro became the official currency of 11 member states of the European Union with a fixed conversion rate against their national currencies. The value of the euro will fluctuate according to market conditions against the dollar and all other currencies, including those of the four member states not participating in the euro zone. Although euro notes and coins will not appear until January 1, 2002, the new currency now can be used in the form of checks, travelers checks, bank transfers, credit cards or electronic purses by consumers, commercial enterprises and governmental administrations.
