# PERSONAL MONEY ALLOWANCE

#### 3101 <u>ENTITLEMENT</u>

310101. <u>Officers</u>. Officers in the capacities listed in Table 31-1 below who are entitled to receive basic pay are also entitled to receive a personal money allowance. This allowance is in addition to any other pay or allowance authorized.

310102. <u>Enlisted Members</u>. An enlisted member, serving as the senior enlisted member of his or her Military Service, is also entitled to receive a personal money allowance. This allowance is in addition to any other pay or allowance authorized.

### 3103 TAXABILITY AND WITHHOLDING TAX
