

FOOD SERVICE CHARGES AT THE MILITARY ACADEMIES  
FISCAL YEAR 2009

The provisions of Chapter 20, "Military Academy Dining Hall Operations," Volume 12, "Special Accounts, Funds and Programs," of the DoD Financial Management Regulation (DoD 7000.14-R), stipulate that the daily amount of subsistence shall be prescribed by the Secretary of Defense for each Military Department that operates a Service Academy dining hall in support of cadets or midshipmen. The daily academy dining hall (Cadets and Midshipmen) rates for fiscal year 2009, are effective October 1, 2008. The discount and standard rates are effective January 1, 2009.

**SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING CHANGES TO THESE RATES**

**The rate below for Cadets and Midshipmen is effective as of October 1, 2008. This rate is equivalent to the Enlisted Basic Allowance for Subsistence rate that was effective January 1, 2008. A new rate will be set for the Cadets and Midshipmen effective January 1, 2009 and will be equal to the Enlisted Basic Allowance for Subsistence rate that will be effective on January 1, 2009**
