Composite hourly rates and target hour ceilings for contract administration and contract audit services to be provided by DoD activities to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) for FY 2018 are as follows:

- 1/ The DCMA is responsible for the management and further distribution of the target hour ceiling under their control.
- 2/ DoD Components are to manage to the established target ceilings. The hours associated with the DoD Components shall not exceed the approved target hours ceiling. If the DoD Components determine that the target ceiling will be exceeded, the Component must seek guidance from HQ NASA.
